

THE RUBIK HELICOPTER FACEBOOK COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The promoter is Abland (Pty) Ltd (company reg no: 1996/013517/07), whose registered office is at Abcon House, Fairway Office Park, Grosvenor Road, Bryanston, 2021.
2. The competition is open to residents of the Republic of South Africa aged 18 years or over, except employees of Abland (Pty) Ltd and their close relatives and anyone otherwise connected with the organization or judging the competition.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
5. Route to entry for the competition and details of how to enter are via The Rubik's posts on their page on Facebook. (https://www.facebook.com/TheRubikCapeTown/?epa=SEARCH_BOX).
6. This competition will be run on the Facebook social media platform from The Rubik's Page, as per the link in 5.
7. Only one entry will be accepted per person per day. Multiple entries from the same person in one day will not be counted.
8. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
9. The closing date for the competition is 4 October 2019, at 17:00. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
10. Abland (Pty) Ltd reserved the right to cancel the competition if circumstances arise outside of its control.
11. The rules of the competition and how to enter are as follows:
 - 11.1. The Rubik Facebook page will post one post per day for the duration of the competition.
 - 11.2. The entrant is expected to follow the instructions on the post for entry, such as answering a question, or filling in the blank of a sentence.
 - 11.3. The entrant needs to like the Rubik's Facebook page, the post created, as well as leave a comment in order to be eligible for an entry into the competition.
 - 11.4. Once entered, the top 10 or 5 entries (as stated in the post on that day) will be eligible to enter into the lucky draw that will take place at the end of the competition.
 - 11.5. A participant is allowed more than one entry during the week run of the competition, should that person receive more than one entry during the run of the competition.
